

Election Scrapbook Assignment

During the election, create your own scrapbook to track the people, events and issues of the campaign and record your experience.

Your scrapbook should include information about the election, such as:

- The Student Vote program
- The parties and their platforms
- The local candidates
- Campaign debates or events
- Issues of provincial and local importance
- Results of opinion polls
- Why it is important to vote
- The election results

Your scrapbook should include some or all of the following:

- Title page/front cover
- Introduction to the election
- Articles
- Newscast summaries
- Photos
- Links to websites
- Campaign literature
- Political cartoons
- Personal reflections

Describe the 5 Ws for at least one of each of the following in your scrapbook: article, photo, cartoon and summary of a newscast.

- Who is the article, image, cartoon or newscast about?
- What is the argument of the article, point of the cartoon, theme of the newscast?
- Where is this taking place? Is the *where* significant?
- When did this occur? Is the *when*/timing important?
- Why was this article, image or political cartoon included here?
