<p><b>ISSUES</b>          Politicians or candidates talk about issues that are important to me.</p> <p><i>Somewhat/strongly agree=1; Somewhat/strongly disagree=0.</i></p>	
<p><b>PERSONAL CONFIDENCE</b>          Sometimes politics and government seem so complicated that someone like me can't really understand what's going on.</p> <p><i>Somewhat/strongly disagree=1; Somewhat/strongly agree=0.</i></p>	
<p><b>ATTITUDES TOWARDS POLITICIANS AND GOVERNMENT</b>          I do not think politicians or the government care much about what people like me think.</p> <p><i>Somewhat/strongly disagree=1; Somewhat/strongly agree=0.</i></p>
