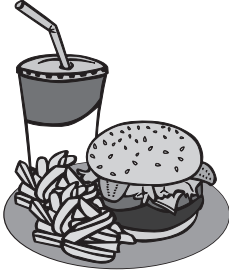


**Let's Eat!**
